- Your own wireless internet connection (if required)
- Headphones

- Power boards and extension cords
- Nametags

Walk-ins will be accepted, however we would prefer for you to pre-register with us prior to the event so that we can promote your participation on our website. To register, please email me at anthony@letsmakegames.org with your team/company name and logo, your game name and a screenshot of your game.

Registrations at the event will happen between 12:00 to 12:30. Please bring your equipment for set up during this time to **Room 3.111** where we will get your power and desk requirements sorted. If you decide to bring your own power boards or extension cords, please label these clearly with your name.

Internet & Audio

There will not be wireless internet available from the venue. If your game requires an internet connection, please make sure to organise your own wireless internet solution.

A showreel and the presentation schedule will be playing throughout the showcase. If your game relies on audio, make sure to bring a set of headphones!
